Intelicode® 17.0.0.4 is available for download and installation. This update includes the 2021 CPT codes and 2021 AMA Guidelines. You will need to install this update to enter visits with 2021 dates.

Please remember to always back up your data before any update.

If you are updating from Version 16 your activation should remain valid and running the program after the installation will attempt to update your databases. Q: How is Intelicode handling changes for the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency?

A: We have added additional telehealth codes and added a telehealth question for services in CMS's list of accepted telehealth services. Office or Other Outpatient services from March through the end of 2020 can code using only time or medical decision making if the telehealth questions are answered appropriately. We've added new COVID-19 testing codes as they have been created and added the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine codes (0001A, 0002A, 91300) effective December 11th, 2020. For P.A.T.H. users, we've updated the teaching physician guidelines to reflect changes in supervision requirements.
